ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 Cr. P.C. (REVISED-2)

WHEREAS, vide Order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV- 3804 dated 24.03.2020 the undersigned has already imposed CURFEW within the entire territorial jurisdiction of District Solan, Himachal Pradesh; which was ordered to be revised vide Order No. SLN/Reader/DM/1-14/89-IV- 3818 dated 25.03.2020. Now, keeping in view changed facts and circumstances, the undersigned hereby orders to revise the previous Order as under:

That this order shall not be applicable to the following:

1. Hospitals (both public and private) as well as nursing homes, including persons visiting such hospitals/nursing homes for medical emergency.
2. Health Officials including AYUSH and Homeopathy officials.
3. District Administration.
4. Government servants on Magisterial duty and District Disaster Management Authority.
5. Police, Military, Para Military Forces, Home Guards, Civil defence and other Security Forces which are under the control of State or Central Government.
6. Prisons.
7. Government or Semi-Government employees on duty pertaining to mitigation of COVID-19 as certified by concerned Sub-Divisional Magistrate.
8. Officers/Officials involved in operational maintenance of essential services pertaining to the Electricity, Water and Municipal Service.
9. Fire service(s).
10. Treasury.
11. Banks/ATMs.
12. Insurance Offices.
13. Post Offices.
14. Telecom and internet services including IT and ITeS.
15. Officers/Officials of Animal Husbandry Department, Forest Department, Road infrastructure.
16. Petrol Pumps, LPG gas, Oil agencies, their godowns and their transportation related activities.
17. E-Commerce (delivery) of all essential goods including food, pharmaceuticals and medical equipments.
18. Production and Manufacturing units which require continuous process may continue to function, after obtaining required permission from the undersigned



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and following all precautionary protocols as notified by Health department from time to time.

19. All Food Processing Companies to keep their manufacturing facilities open.
20. Cold Storages and warehousing services.
21. Units manufacturing alcohol for medicines/sanitizers and engaged in production of essential commodities including Drugs, Pharmaceutical, Medical Devices, Soap/Detergents, their raw material and intermediates as well as their ancillaries, together with related transportation.

*Provided that,*

- a. *Movement of workers from their residence/accommodation to the Factory and return through factory owned/hired buses/vehicles has to be within State. Provided that same shall not carry workers more than 70% of its total seating capacity including Driver, subject to the Permission/Pass issued by concerned Sub Divisional Magistrates (SDMs) or Assistant Commissioner (Protocol) Parwanoo.*
  - b. *Uniform shifts pattern in all factories should be observed.*
  - c. *Before entering the factory premises, hands should be properly washed and the body temperature of the workers should be checked through thermal scanner. In case, any worker is found with high body temperature or any symptoms of COVID-19, then he/she shall be immediately sent to nearest health institution and prescribed measures to be followed. Further, same should be immediately intimated to the Administration.*
  - d. *Social distancing protocol of separation between workers by two meters be meticulously followed,*
  - e. *Premises should be frequently sanitized,*
  - f. *All Labour Laws shall be followed meticulously.*
22. Shops or stores selling Groceries, Milk, Bread, Fruits, Vegetables, Meat, Fish, other uncooked food items and animal fodder. These shops will remain open from 08:00 A.M to 11:00 A.M. Further, the Chemist Shops will remain open from 10:00 A.M. to 05:00 P.M, so that general public could access the above mentioned essential facilities/services. However, under no circumstances there shall be assembly of five or more persons anywhere out of their houses. Any movement of general public during the above mentioned period will be strictly restricted from home to essential services establishment and back.
23. Sabzi Mandies of APMC situated at Solan and Nalagarh shall also function between 07:00 A.M to 11:00 A.M.
24. Milkmen catering to the needs of people for home delivery as per existing practice.
25. Insecticides and pesticides shops (both Govt. and Private), subject to the condition that they shall remain open between 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM only.

  
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26. Hotels, Guest Houses and Home Stays, which otherwise are closed, are permitted to be used for the stay of persons who are stranded and held up due to curfew.
27. Establishments earmarked for quarantine facilities.
28. Authorized Print and Electronic Media personnels.

**NOTE:**

1. **All abovementioned offices/institutions/shops/premises shall be frequently sanitized.**
2. **Skeletal staff to be deployed after exercising due prudence.**
3. **All Officers/Officials of abovementioned Offices/Departments shall carry their respective Identity Cards issued by their concerned Head of the Department.**

It is further, ordered that only one member of the family/household shall be allowed to step out for procuring essential supplies and these should be procured from nearest shop in the vicinity. Use of vehicles shall be avoided at all costs. Immediately after the procurement of essential item(s), the person shall return to his/her home and shall follow social distancing norms and avoid crowding- **failing which, he/she shall be liable for penal action.** Any person violating these containment measures will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action under section 188 of the IPC (as per appendix).

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 17:00 hrs on 26.03.2020 and will remain in operation for next 20 days.


In view of the emergent nature of the order, it is being issued ex-parte and addressed to the Public in general.

The compliance of these orders shall be ensured by the Executive Magistrates (including those especially appointed) and Police Officers/ officials. Violation may be strictly dealt with under relevant provision of the IPC.

This order shall be promulgated by the announcement through publicity vans and through press notes as well as social media for publication in the newspapers having circulation in the area.
