

Proceedings of the 12th Meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) constituted under the Disaster Management Act 2005 held on 25th April, 2020 at 4:30 PM under the Chairmanship of Sh. Anil Kumar Khachi, Chief Secretary -cum- Chairman (SEC) in H.P. Secretariat, Shimla.

A meeting of the State Executive Committee constituted under the Disaster Management Act 2005 was held on 25th April, 2020 at 4:30 PM under the Chairmanship of Sh. Anil Kumar Khachi, Chief Secretary -cum- Chairman State Executive Committee (SEC) in H.P. Secretariat, Shimla.

2. The Principal Secretary (Revenue) to the Govt. of H.P. welcomed the Chairman, and Members of the SEC. He apprised the Committee of the current status of COVID-19 pandemic in the State and actions being taken by the Disaster Management Cell, Department of Revenue to effectively implement the lockdown measures and ensure the supply of essential commodities. Committee was informed that the Emergency Operation Centres (EOCs) set up at State and District Headquarters have been working round the clock. These Centres have been collecting information and providing assistance to the stranded and needy persons.

3. After detailed discussion following decisions were taken:

- i. SEC confirmed the proceedings of the 11th Meeting of SEC held on 9th April 2020.
- ii. SEC as per the Section 24 (I) of the DM Act 2005 has resolved to implement the guidelines issued by the Central Government from time to time in response to the COVID -19 outbreak.
