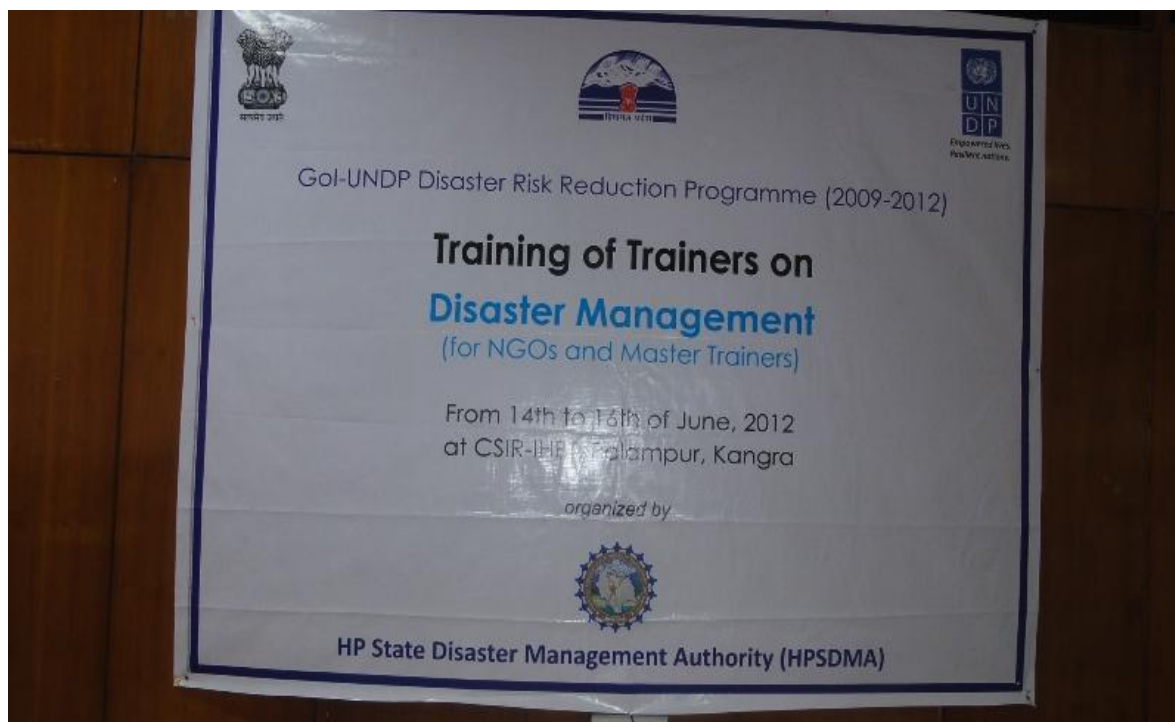


GOI-UNDP DRR Programme (2009-2012)



Three Day Training of NGOs in Disaster Management 14-16 June, 2012 CSIR-IHBT, Palampur, Kangra

A Three Day Training programme on Training of Trainers (TOT) on Disaster Management was organized from 14-16 June, 2012 at the premises of CSIR-IHBT, Palampur, Kangra for the NGOs of district Kangra, and Mandi under GOI-UNDP DRR Programme (2009-12).

40 participants from 23 NGOs attended the training programme.

Day 1: 14th June, 2012

After the registration of the participants, reading material was distributed among the participants.

The training programme started with the welcome note by UN Volunteer, Shimla, Mr. Navneet Yadav. After that State Project Officer Mr. D.C Rana introduced the UNDP team and it was followed by the introduction of the participants & their expectation from the training programme. The first session of the training programme was taken by Dr. R.K Sood, Prof and Head, DM, HIPA, Shimla. He gave presentation on Basic Concepts of DM & HRVA profile of H.P. He covered the following topics in his presentation:-

1. Disaster theory of anger of God
2. Theory of fury of Nature
3. What is Disaster
4. Natural & Man-made Disaster
5. Key elements of Disasters
6. Himachal Pradesh Vulnerability and Risk Profile vis a vis major Disasters

In the second session of the training programme Mr. D.C Rana, SPO UNDP briefed the participants about the GOI-UNDP DRR Programme, its aims and objectives and deliverables. Thereafter, he gave a detailed presentation on the institutional framework of Disaster Management in the country and role of NGOs in DM and covered mainly the following topics:-

1. Disaster Management Act-2005 – its key features
2. Institutional Mechanism at the National Level
3. State Disaster Management Authority
4. District Disaster Management Authority
5. Role of NGOs in Disaster Management

After the lunch, Mr. Anup Karanth, Consultant, Taru Leading Edge explained through presentations the issue on Mainstreaming Disaster Risk Reduction into developmental programmes and covered the following topics:-

1. Key Terms
2. Events (Image from the past disaster)
3. Risk and Risk Reduction
4. Paradigm Shift in DRR
5. Mainstreaming, what it means?
6. Case Studies

Thereafter, the participants were asked to identify stakeholder on DM. The list of stakeholder in DM were drawn with the active contribution of the participants. This made them understood the different stakeholder and their role in DM.

Day 2: 15th June, 2012

Second day started with the Recap Session coordinated by Neerja, DPA, Mandi in which the participants actively participated.

After the Recap Session of the second day, Mr. Anup Karanth, Consultant, Taru Leading Edge shared tips with participants on earthquake phenomenon, earthquake structural damages and Structural safety of Building in earthquake hazard prone areas which involved following topics:-

1. Earthquake Hazard Risk
2. Consequences & damage to building
3. Family preparedness
4. Case studies of different earthquake

In post lunch session, Mr Rakesh Bhardwaj, Commandant Home Guard, Kangra at Dharamshala taught basic search & rescue techniques to the participants, which also included practical demonstration and practice by the participants on the following topic:-

1. Search Orientation
2. Primary & secondary search
3. Search Methods
4. Search Priorities
5. Search Area Safety
6. Use of Knots
7. Basic Rescue techniques using improvised methods/techniques

Thereafter, the Fire Officer, Palampur, gave basic fire safety tips and conducted practical session on use of fire equipment for the participants.

After this session, Mr. D.C Rana, SPO shared a presentation on the “Community Based Disaster Management” in which following topics were discussed:-

1. Role of community in Disaster Management
2. Importance of Community Awareness
3. Capacity Building
4. Bottom Up Approach in Disaster Management
5. Traditional Approach in Disaster Management
6. Models of CBDP
7. Challenges of Community Preparedness

Day 3: 16th July, 2012

Third day started with the recap session of the previous day by Miss Neerja (DPA-Mandi). Participants actively contributed to the recap session.

Recap Session was followed by a presentation by UN Volunteer, Shimla, Mr. Navneet Yadav on Capacity building for awareness & sensitization for DRR which included the following topics:-

1. Case Studies
2. How can NGOs contribute in Disaster Management
3. Various ways to generate awareness about disaster Management
4. How NGOs can mainstream DRR into their existing programme
5. How NGOs can collaborate with HPSDMA
6. How NGOs can generate resources in a creative way

Miss Neerja, DPA Mandi, thereafter, apprised the participants on Mainstreaming Gender issues in various phases of Disaster Management, in which she discussed on the following issues:-

1. Difference between Gender & Sex
2. Vulnerability of women to Disasters
3. Why Gender?
4. Hyogo Framework for action & Gender
5. Case Studies
6. Key areas to mainstream Gender into Disaster Management

Aftertea break Dr. Arun Chandan, Ayurvedic Medical Officer, Kangra shared information about Sphere Project, GO-NGO and IAG Coordination and covered the following topics:-

1. What is Sphere?
2. Sphere India : Process of Collaboration
3. Outreach of Sphere India
4. Inter Agency Group
5. What IAGs do in Emergencies
6. Non – negotiable Principles for IAGs

Thereafter, Mr. D.C Rana, SPO divided the participants into four groups for group work activity. Repeat of 1905 Kangra earthquake scenario was presented to the participants and keeping in view the scenario the participants were asked to identify problems and solutions in post-disaster phase for the sector given to them. Each group was assigned one problem in post disaster scenario. One topic each was given to the four groups.

1. Education
2. Health
3. Livelihood

4. Shelter

Later on the participants in four groups made presentation on the sector given to them.

At the end of the workshop, Mr D.C Rana, State Project Officer thanked the participants for attending the workshop and certificate were distributed among the participants.

The participants appreciated the training and efforts put in by the entire team led by the SPO in organising the training and further added that this training has made them aware about the need for working in DRR issues and they would do their best to raise awareness amongst the community.
