

Sustainable reduction in Disaster Risk in 2 most multi hazard prone district Kinnaur and Kangra in H.P

Project on Sustainable Reduction in Disaster Risk in 10 Multi-Hazard prone districts in 5 States of India-

Introduction: The Project was started in June, 2016 with the aim to strengthen community and local self-government's preparedness and response in 10 most multi-hazard vulnerable Districts, 2 each in 5 identified States i.e. Assam, Bihar, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu & Kashmir and Uttarakhand.

Project Cost: Project cost is Rs. 6.07 Crores

Duration: Implementation period of the scheme is 24 months.

Deliverables: The deliverables of the project briefly include:

- (i) Comprehensive Disaster Risk Reduction/Recovery Plan for each District;
- (ii) Awareness/Publicity Campaigns throughout the selected District;
- (iii) Preparation/Updation of training modules in CBDM;
- (iv) Formation of Disaster Management Teams at District Levels;
- (v) Training of trainers/stakeholders on CBDM;
- (vi) Conduction of mock drills in selected District.

The said project aims to strengthen the capabilities/capacities of the communities' local self-government in the areas of preparedness and response within these districts.
