ORDER

Whereas there has been a huge spike in the number of COVID-19 cases in recent days after re-opening of more activities and particularly during the gathering of large number of people in different locations due to social/ academic /sports /entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political and other congregations, etc.

Therefore, in continuation of State Executive Committee's Orders No. Rev (DMC)(C)20-2/2020-COVID-19 dated 30th October 2020 and amendments dated 18th November 2020, and in exercise of the powers conferred under the Section 24 (e) of the DM Act 2005, the undersigned in capacity of the Chairman, State Executive Committee (SEC), hereby orders the following additions & amendments in the Orders and directs all the Departments & Organisations of the Government, District Magistrates, Police Officers/Officials and Local Authorities of the State to ensure strict implementation of the directions:

I. Additions

- 1) There will be Night Curfew in district Mandi, Shimla, Kullu and Kangra from 8.00 PM to 6.00 AM w.e.f. 24.11.2020 to 15.12.2020. There shall be no movement of persons and vehicles except those involved in the maintenance/delivery of essential/emergency goods &/or services or in case of medical emergency during these hours for the period mentioned above. Respective District Magistrate will issue orders in this regard.
- 2) Inter-State as well as Intra State buses will operate at 50% of capacity till December 15, 2020. Transport Department will issue necessary Orders in this regard.
- 3) Weekly 'Closing Day' for all the markets/shops shall be Sunday throughout the State irrespective of any provisions/orders issued under any other law for the time being, till December 15, 2020.

II. Amendments

4) *In social/ academic/ sports/ entertainment/ cultural/ religious/ political and other congregations, limit of number of persons will be as under: -*

- i. *In open spaces, in areas outside the Containment Zones, keeping the size of the ground/space in view, number of persons allowed will be 50% of the capacity subject to maximum of 200 persons and with strict observance of social distancing, mandatory wearing of face masks, provision of thermal scanning and hand wash or sanitizer.*
- ii. *In closed spaces, in areas outside the Containment Zones, number of persons allowed shall be 50% of the hall capacity subject to maximum of 100 persons. Wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, provision of thermal scanning and use of hand wash or sanitizer will be mandatory in all such venues.*
